Program Description

We are glad you are interested in joining the **Leadership Crucible**. During this year-long program, participants engage in a series of workshops given one Saturday each month (September through July). These workshops focus on:

- helping participants see themselves as leaders
- developing leadership skills
- reinforcing the qualities of effective leaders (e.g., honest, inspiring, courageous)
- building strategies to mitigate the unique problems faced by women leaders in South Sudan
- helping participants identify mentors and begin to build professional networks

The program also includes a mentoring component through which each participant is assigned a mentor to advise and help them. In addition, Leadership Crucible graduates will be eligible to participate in on-going programs after they graduate.

The program is free. The program is also competitive. Only women with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher should apply.

Interested women are required to submit an application (attached). Finalists will be invited to an interview, and asked to take an English test. We plan to accept approximately 20 students for the next academic year.
